Notable namesakes: Robbins Rd., Robbins Hill,

Name Meaning - This interesting surname is a medieval male given name "Robin", a form of Robert, from the short form "Rob", plus the hypocoristic suffix "-in". It is in the Domesday Book of 1086. Robin came originally from France, and the name was made popular by Robin Goodfellow and Robin Hood. The surname is first found in the latter half of the 13th Century, and Margaret Robines appears in the Hundred Rolls of Cambridgeshire (1279). 10 Aug 1539 and Thomas Robbins married Jane Brown 26 May 1566. In Ireland the name is found as Robins and Robbins, the origin being English, the first Church Recording was Anthony Robbins. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of Dera Robins, which was dated 1273.¹

Dana Herbert Robbins, son of Ruel W. Robbins and Rebecca Shaw Norton was born in 18 Mar 1877 in Maine. According to the WWI registration, he had light blue eyes and dark brown hair. He was white and native born and in 1918 lived at R.F.D. # 1 Madison, Somerset, Maine . Dana married **Edith Dean**, daughter of Ezra Merrill Deane and Delia Mary Witham,² 11 Sept, 1901.³ They were both resided in Madison, ME. They lived with Ruel and Rebecca Norton Robbins. When a young man, Dana worked for an apple packing company. He was the boss who went to the cellars to pack apples for shipment to Boston. One story he told was this: "I took my crew to a cellar where the apples were chilled. I told them not to touch the apples, for each place they touched them would leave a dark mark. First, we had to start a fire and get them thawed before we packed them." Dana was a butcher and livestock buyer. Each weekend he dressed lambs to deliver to stores in town. He was good at sharing with neighbors in need, either gifts or loans. At one time Dana had a red roan horse named Prince that lived for 20 years.⁴ Dana also did not drink liquor. Dana was a farmer on his own farm in Madison, Maine. He and Edith could both read and write. He was born before automobiles became popular and lived to see man walk on the moon.

In 1909, they hired Ephriam Dean to rebuild the main part of the house. Edith insisted on a round corner on the stairwell and a round closet in the one downstairs bedroom. She got her way, and now it is unique having no squared off corners in the living area. That year, their daughter Dorris was born. Edith Dean Robbins was a lady. No one used bad words around her. She was an excellent seamstress and knew how to make new clothes out of old ones. She also made big round cheeses and root beer for haying seasons. Edith raised laying hens that she talked and sang to so they would lay more eggs. She also raised gray foxes to sell their pelts for fur coats.⁵

Notes for Edith Dean: her mother was Delia⁶ and her brother was Walter. There was a distant relative named, Orin. Edith's mother or her grandmother was Indian.⁷ Edith Dean and

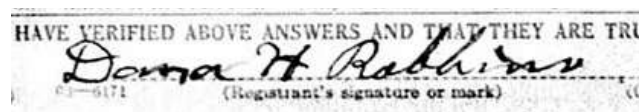
